Throughout the year we have been working hard to meet challenging targets set for our school. We are currently evaluating our progress and we welcome your input and feedback to help us plan for future developments.

This past year we have been extremely busy introducing and implementing the government's new curriculum, which has incorporated:-

- PE and Sports sessions with qualified experts
- Continuation of high quality musical opportunities with the teaching of the ukulele to Yr4 and 5 classes.
- Introduction of fascinating texts for each class to read and to build their writing experiences around.

In addition we have:-

- Boosted children's enjoyment of Reading through regular visits to Larkfield Library and with our activities during Book Week plus the current reading competition.
- We have enlisted the support and collaboration of the Behaviour Support Team and together with Lego therapy, these measures have addressed the specific needs of some of our children.
- During this last term, Yr3 have been shopping for ingredients and have baked delicious bread; Yr4 have demonstrated their knowledge about Romans in their assembly; Yr5 have enjoyed a sleep-over following their class text 'Goodnight Mr Tom'.
- Then of course, Yr6 have enjoyed a plethora of experiences ~ their play, the residential visit to Isle of Wight and the Activity Week, the Prom
- We thank the PTFA for all their organisation and efforts to raise money for the school whilst giving the children fun and exciting activities.
- Our School Council representatives have organised competitions and have been promoting Healthy Eating choices. They have also been involved in making decisions regarding our school meals ~ together with our school governors, they have initiated some changes for September.
- Groups of children have represented our school and successfully taken part in enrichment activities and competitions with other schools in Maths, Science and Writing ~ all of which has helped to promote their learning and enjoyment of these areas of the curriculum.
- We have strengthened our local community links with visits to Morrisons to buy ingredients for cooking; visits to TESCOs who have also provided us with free fruit on several occasions for our healthy playtime snacks for all children.
- We are extremely proud of our hard-working children across the school ~ especially in Yr6 where their SATs scores showed their fantastic progress in all 3 subjects ~ Reading, Writing and Maths.
- The attendance at After-school clubs has increased, with the huge variety of opportunities to broaden the children's enjoyment and experiences.
