Through the monitoring of our class registers this term we have concluded that average attendance figures for each class are as follows:-

As a whole school our average attendance for Term 5 was **95.85%.** This is better than last term, and hopefully a sign of our home and school partnership working well for the continuous programme of learning resulting positively in our children's progress and development.
