Dear Parent/Carer

As your child is moving into Year 6 in September 2017, they are invited to attend a 2 day bicycle training course delivered by KCC - Kent Bikeability.

It is a national standard cycle training course designed to give your child the skills and confidence to ride their bike on today's roads. They will take part in Level 1 and 2 training which will teach them: how to control their bikes, to make manoeuvres safely, how to complete basic bike safety checks, improve their knowledge of important road signs and increase their observational skills when cycling on the road.

We are arranging for the training course to take place between 14th November – 29th November and we would like to know if your child would like to participate in this training.

For them to do so there will be a fee of £10 per child (charge set by KCC), they must have access to a road worthy bike and cycle helmet.

Please find attached an information booklet about the course and bike check information. Please read details carefully. At the back of the booklet is a parental Consent Form that **MUST** be completed and signed if your child would like to take part. Without this form they **will not** be able to do so.

We need to know if your child would like to take part, please could we ask you to return the slip below and fill in the consent form sending both back to school by 18th July 2017. Payment can be made via the school money system and a link will be sent for you to be able to make this payment on the 19th July, alternatively you can send money or cheque in a named envelope.
