Dear Parents and Carers

We are writing to tell you about our Year 4 educational visit to Canterbury, on Thursday 4th June. Children will have the opportunity to visit three museums. This is a fabulous opportunity for the pupils of Brookfield. Children will take part in exciting activities which will include hands on tasks as part of a Roman Technology day. Activities include grinding corn using a quern stone, make and fire mini 'Onager' catapults and hammer their own metal Roman coin. The three museums the pupils will visit are; The Beany Gallery, The Roman Museum and Canterbury Heritage Centre.

We intend to leave the school at 8:40am, so please make sure your child is in school for 8:15am ready for an early registration before we leave.

We will leave Canterbury for the return journey to school at 2pm sharp hoping to return to school by 3:15pm, traffic permitting. *(We will notify the school office if the coach gets held up so a text can be sent out notifying parents and carers of any delay, so please make sure your current details are all up to date with the school office.)* The PTFA have kindly contributed a substantial amount towards this visit, therefore we are asking parents for a voluntary contribution of £13.95 to cover the rest of the cost. *(A £1.00 refund will be given should the weather be on our side meaning the children can eat lunch outside instead of the booked lunch room.)*

As you have completed a BJS-V4 form there is no need to fill out a new one as we will use these details and information to cover your child on this visit, however if there are any changes to their personal information and/or your child's medical condition, please kindly fill out a new form which is obtainable from the school office before the visit takes place.
