Dear Parents and Carers

With the exciting Year 5 trip to Harry Potter World fast approaching, we would like to take this opportunity to remind you of a few key points surrounding the day.

Firstly, after careful consideration by the Year 5 staff it has been decided, for health and safety reasons, that children will be required to wear full school uniform for the day, rather than wearing a Harry Potter inspired costume, thus making it easier for members of staff and other helpers to keep a watchful eye over the children in the spacious Harry Potter studios. There is an opportunity, however, in the same week as the visit, for your child to wear their Harry Potter inspired costume to school as part of our book week celebrations.

Secondly, children will need to bring to school with them a packed lunch; they will be required to carry this with them throughout the day, and therefore a suitable bag will be needed. Alongside this, lunch will be eaten in an outside space; children should be prepared for this, bringing or wearing a coat.

Finally, we aim to arrive back at school at 4.30pm; please allow the children to come into the school building and settle in the hall to allow for an organised dismissal to parents and carers. Once the children are inside we will ask parents to come in and collect their child in a similar way to afterschool clubs. If your child usually walks home unaccompanied and you wish for this to happen on the day, please advise your child's class teacher. If there are any changes to this, perhaps due to traffic and travel, we will endeavour to keep you updated on the day via the schools texting system.
