**Dear Parents and Carers** 

As many of you will be aware a new curriculum was introduced in all state-funded schools from September 2014; here at Brookfield Junior School we have embraced the changes and have begun a successful transition. To continue this transition, we will be adopting a new approach to learning in Science, History, Geography, Art and DT in Years 3, 4 and 5; these subjects will be taught in weekly blocks rather than one lesson per week.

The aim for block teaching is to improve the fluency within learning, allowing lessons to be taught on consecutive days, reducing the need to recap previous learning within each lesson. Alongside a more fluent approach, block teaching also allows better links to be made between different areas of learning. For example, if Science is being taught it may be beneficial to centre Maths learning on data handling.

To help support your child, we feel it is vitally important to keep you updated on the topic areas, to allow you to answer any questions at home. Below is a table outlining the learning for Years 3, 4 and 5 in Term 5:
