Dear Parents/Carers

On Tuesday 7th July, Hugh Christie School in Tonbridge are hosting a 'Science Olympics' competition for Primary schools in the Tonbridge and Malling area. We are pleased to have secured a place for a team of four budding scientists to attend.

I am delighted to inform you that your child has been selected to represent Brookfield Junior School at this event. The children will be travelling to Hugh Christie with a member of our staff, on a minibus provided by Snodland CEP School. The day will begin at 9.30am; therefore the children will depart from school at approximately 9am. The activities will then run for the duration of the morning finishing at around midday. The children will then return to school to eat their lunch and join their classes for the afternoon session.

The objectives of the day are for the children to work together as a team, apply their Science knowledge, design and build as well as carry out testing. These skills will be applied in 3, 30 minutes challenges, involving only the use of A4 paper, scissor and sellotape. The challenges will be judged by Student Leaders at the school and points allocated to winning teams. At the end of the 3 challenges, the points will be added together and medals will be award to the 3 highest scoring teams.

As the children will be representing our school, we expect full school uniform to be worn, including the correct footwear and long hair to be tied up. Please provide your child with a water bottle and a snack.
