Monday 15th June will be the start of our Health and Fitness Week here at Brookfield Junior School. This week will focus on the pupils developing their understanding of what is meant by healthy living as well as encouraging greater participation in sporting activities. Following the success in previous years of different activities the week will include: Football, Boccia, Dodge ball and Handball.

We will be holding our school <u>Sports Day on Wednesday 17th June</u>, to which you are invited. In case of bad weather our reserve Sports Day will be on Thursday 18th June. The day will be run as follows:-

- Whole school Potted Sports 10.30am 12.15pm.
- Lunch 12.15pm 1.25pm
- Whole school Sprints and Relays 1.45pm 3.00pm approximately.

Following the successes of previous years we would again like to offer parents and carers the opportunity to stay for a picnic lunch. Bring with you a picnic that will be eaten on the school field; please do not bring any alcohol. The PTFA will be available to serve refreshments on the day for a small charge.

The presentation of the Sports Day cup will be made in assembly on Friday 19th June, following the accumulation of all points scored in activities throughout the week.

Your child will need their P.E kit, including appropriate footwear for both indoor and outdoor activities, and at least one bottle of water every day. Jewellery must be removed in order to participate. Children will each be provided with a Brookfield Junior School baseball cap and putting sun cream on before coming to school if the weather looks good, is advisable.

Professional Sports Photographers from the company DE Photo will be present for the WHOLE of our Sports Day. We have used this company on several occasions and are very impressed by the standard. Photos of your children taking part in all the Potted Sports events and the afternoon sprint and relay races will be captured.
