Dear Parents and Carers

As we are quickly approaching Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> January and the Year 5 children begin their final concert preparations, I would like to remind you of the details for the day.

The children should arrive to school as normal on the morning of Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> January and will depart from school at approximately 11am. They will arrive at The O2 arena with time to eat their lunch prior to being seated and beginning rehearsals at 1.30pm. At 5pm, the children will stop rehearsals and have an opportunity to eat their packed dinners. On this day, it is therefore necessary for your child to have two packed meals. If your child receives a free school meal and you require us to provide this on the day, please indicate on the reply slip below.

The concert will begin at 7pm and end at approximately 9.15pm. The children will be required to remain in their seats at the end of the concert as dismissing the choirs in an orderly fashion is required for health and safety reasons. The children will then all return to school by coach with the accompanying adults. A text will be sent to you when the children are back on the coach and starting their homeward journey with an estimated time for collection. Please ensure you check your phone to ensure your child is collected promptly from the school site.

It will not be possible for individual children to be collected from the O2, however, we appreciate many parents will be supporting their child from the audience. If you are attending the event and think you are going to arrive back to school later than the children, please do not panic.

As outlined in the initial letter in September, this will be a late night for the children involved. We will therefore allow your child to arrive to school no later than morning playtime on Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> January (10.25am).

While at the O2 Arena, your child may be photographed or filmed by authorised Young Voices members of staff for promotional media. If you have any issues or concerns regarding this, please speak with your child's class teacher.

We have purchased a Young Voices T-shirt for every child attending the event. If you would like for your child to keep the T-shirt as a memento of this experience, please tick this option on the reply slip below and return with a £10 fee. This money covers only the cost of the T-shirt already incurred by the school. Children will need to arrive to school in their full school uniform on their day, T-shirts being provided following their arrival.

As you have completed a BJS-V4 (yellow form) we intend using this information to cover this visit. However, if there are any changes regarding your child's medical condition, a new BJS-V4 (yellow form) needs to be completed and returned to school before the visit takes place. Please note that it is your responsibility to keep the school up-dated with any medical changes concerning your son/daughter.
