



Year 4 Educational Visit to Canterbury

Dear Parents/Carers

Due to the fantastic positive response we had following the letter sent home last week we are now writing to let you know that the educational trip to Canterbury, **on Thursday 6th July** will be taking place.

This is a fabulous opportunity for the pupils of Brookfield. Children will take part in exciting activities which will include hands-on tasks as part of a Roman Technology day. At the Heritage Museum, pupils will find out for themselves the different types of jobs both Roman workers did as well as the slaves. Grinding corn, using a quern stone, making and firing mini 'Onager' catapults and hammering their own metal Roman coin to take home, are just some of the opportunities on offer. When the children arrive at the Roman Museum, they will be taking part in a fun hands-on workshop, in which children take on the role of archaeologists investigating real artefacts from Roman Canterbury.

We intend to leave the school at 9am, so please make sure your child is on time for school so registration can be taken before boarding the coach. We will leave Canterbury for the return journey to school at 2:15pm sharp hoping to return to school by 3pm, traffic permitting. *(We will notify the school office if the coach gets held up so a text can be sent out notifying parents and carers of any delay, so please make sure your current details are all up to date with the school office)* We are asking parents for a voluntary contribution of £16.80 to cover the rest of the cost.

As you have completed a BJS-V4 form there is no need to fill out a new one as we will use these details and information to cover your child on this visit, however if there are any changes to their personal information and/or your child's medical condition, please kindly fill out a new form which is obtainable from the school office before the visit takes place.
