We have arranged for your child, along with the other children in Year 4, to attend a day's workshop at Horton Kirby Education Centre. The day will support your child's knowledge and understanding of the Year 4 national curriculum unit, Living things and their habitats.

The trip is an exciting opportunity for your child to be immersed in Science by specialist teachers, who have a passion for Primary Science learning. To promote enjoyment and engagement within Science, we will not be asking for payment towards the trip; however we do require the permission slip below to be completed and returned. If you are available to attend the trip, as a parent helper, please indicate this on the return slip below.

The trip will take place within the school day. The children will be collected by a coach at 9am and return to school for approximately 3pm. Children will need to be prepared for outside learning on this day. We expect your child to wear their school jumpers and t-shirts; however as the activities will be outside, they may wear appropriate trousers and shoes. Trainers are permitted on this day. If your child has wellie boots, please ensure they bring them on the day. The facility do have spare boots in a range of sizes for those children without. It would also be beneficial for your child to have a waterproof coat or jacket in case of showers. If the weather forecast is good, please also provide your child with sun cream, we have a Brookfield hat in school they can take.

Please provide your child with a packed lunch – no fizzy drinks or chocolate. If your child receives free school dinners they are entitled to a school packed lunch which will be ready for collection on the day of the visit (please tick below).

As you have completed a BJS-V4 (yellow form) we intend using this information to cover this visit. However, if there are any changes regarding your child's medical condition, a new BJS-V4 (yellow form) needs to be completed and returned to school before the visit takes place. Please note that it is your responsibility to keep the school up-dated with any medical changes concerning your son/daughter.
