Dear Parent/Carer

To keep in line with new government PE initiatives and expectations we will be continuing to offer swimming lessons to children in Year 3, 4 and 5.

Term 1 ~ Year 4
Term 2 ~ Year 4

Term 3 ~ Year 5
Term 4 ~ Year 5

Term 5 ~ Year 3
Term 6 ~ Year 3

Children in Year 5 will be having a course of swimming lessons at Larkfield Leisure Centre, on Wednesday afternoons as follows:-

Term 3:

4th January, 11th January, 18th January, 25th January, 1st February and 8th February.

Heron Class will swim first (at 2pm) so can be collected at the usual time of 3:10pm

Woodpecker Class will swim second (at 2:30pm) so will not be back to school until 3:30pm

Children in Woodpecker Class will NOT be offered an After School Club in Term 3 – however the staff will be providing some ‘in school activities’ until 4:20pm should you wish for your child to stay in school.

Alternatively your child can be collected from the classroom door at 3:30pm when they are swimming second.

Term 4:

22nd February, 1st March, 8th March, 15th March, 22nd March and 29th March.

Woodpecker Class will swim first (at 2pm) so can be collected at the usual time of 3:10pm

Heron Class will swim second (at 2:30pm) so will not be back to school until 3:30pm

Children in Heron Class will NOT be offered an After School Club in Term 4 – however the staff will be providing some ‘in school activities’ until 4:20pm should you wish for your child to stay in school.

Each session will cost **£1.85**, this is a total of **£11.10 payable at the beginning of Term 3** and a further **£11.10 payable at the beginning of Term 4.**

We are pleased to be offering an online payment system – so please wait to receive your text and email with your log in details. Alternatively, please place any cash payments in a named envelope and hand into your class teacher or reception.

A £1.00 coin will also be required for the locker. The locker money will be kept in school until the end of all the swimming sessions.
